With reference to the complaint filed by Gunda Durga Prasad, F/o. Kathyaani Devi (PwD) resident of Kandoji Bazar, Secunderabad, wherein the petitioner alleged that the Principal, St. Anthony's Girls High School has pressuring them to take the TC of their child and asked to admit her in any Government or other school and requested for protection of educational rights of his child as she is suffering from Developmental Delay (Intellectual Disability). This Court has asked Action Taken Report from the Principal, St. Anthony's Girls High School, but no report is received in this court within the stipulated time.

Section 16 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 stipulates that the appropriate Government and the local authorities shall endeavour that all educational institutions funded or recognised by them provide Inclusive Education to the children with disabilities and towards that end shall -

- i) Admit them without discrimination and provide education and opportunities for sports and recreation activities equally with others.
- ii) Make building campus and various facilities accessible.
- iii) Provide reasonable accommodation according to the individual's requirements.
- iv) Provide necessary support individualised or otherwise in environments that maximise academic and social development consistent with the goal of full inclusion.
- v) ensure that the education to persons who are blind or deaf or both is imparted in the most appropriate languages and modes and means of communication;
- vi) Detect specific learning disabilities in children at the earliest and take suitable pedagogical and other measures to overcome them;
- vii) monitor participation, progress in terms of attainment levels and completion of education in respect of every student with disability;
- viii) provide transportation facilities to the children with disabilities and also the attendant of the children with disabilities having high support needs.

As per the complaint, it is observed that the Principal of the above said school has pressuring them to take the TC of their child and asked to admit her in any Government or other school. It is to inform that it is against the provisions of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, which is a violation of law.

In view of the above, **the petitioner and Respondents are summoned to appear before the Court of the State Commissioner at 2.30 PM on 19-06-2026** at Ground floor, Vikalngula Sankshema Bhava, Nalgonda X Roads, Malakpet, Hyderabad for hearing of the case along with relevant material.
